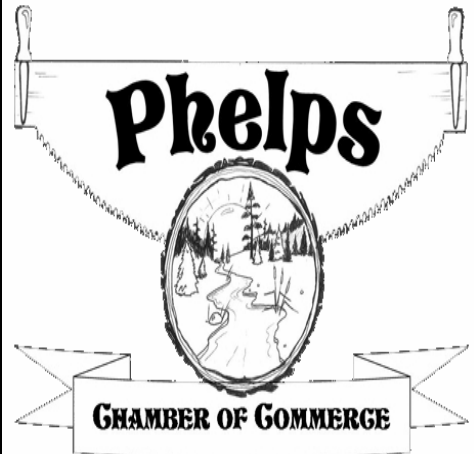

GOVERNOR DOYLE TO VISIT PHELPS

The Phelps Chamber of Commerce is pleased to announce that Governor Doyle will visit Phelps on Saturday, August 21 during his 2010 Northern Tour. The visit will coincide with the community's Open House and Hwy. 17 Re-Dedication. The day's events will begin at 9:00 a.m. with a Farmer's Market in downtown Phelps. The governor is scheduled to visit Phelps from 10:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. and will address the community at the town dock on Hwy. 17 in downtown Phelps. In addition State Senator Jim Holperin and Phelps Town Chairman Pete Albrecht will speak. The governor will also participate in a ribbon cutting ceremony to celebrate the completion of the Hwy. 17 road project.

The newly completed Phelps Historical Museum will be hosting a Grand Opening and wine and cheese tasting from 10 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. The museum is located in downtown Phelps next door to the North Bay Cafe.

The community celebration will continue throughout the day and evening at Wavering Park. Everyone is invited to attend the "Old Timers" Softball Tournament which begins on Friday evening at 6:00 p.m. and continues on Saturday with games beginning at 8:00 a.m. and ending at approximately 10:00 p.m. Games will also be played beginning at 8:00 a.m. on Sunday with the championship game to take place Sunday afternoon. Food, beer and other refreshments will be available for purchase on all three days and there will be live music on Saturday afternoon and evening.
