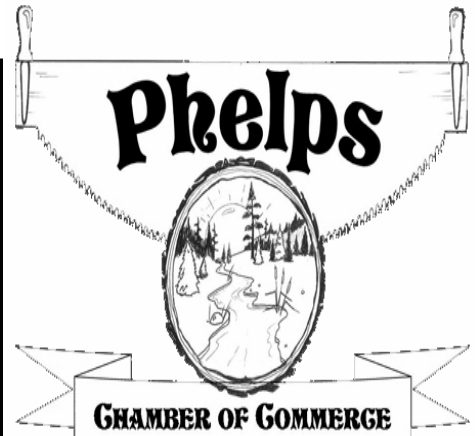

30TH ANNUAL MIDWEST MUSKY CLASSIC

The Phelps Chamber of Commerce held its 30th Annual Midwest Musky Classic on October 1, 2 and 3. More than 90 participants fished on Lac Vieux Desert, North and South Twin and Big Sand Lakes. Only 6 fish were caught during the entire tournament due to the cold front that moved through the area.

This year's winner, Butch Vandenberg from Kaukauna, WI, caught a 48 ³/₄ inch fish Friday morning on Lac Vieux Desert. He was awarded \$1000 and will receive a replica of his fish at next year's tournament. Second place and \$400 went to Kyle Hanke of Oakfield, WI who caught a 46 ¹/₂ inch fish on Big Sand Lake on Friday. Third place and \$200 went to Mike Martin from Waukesha, WI with a 44 inch fish caught on Big Sand Lake on Sunday.

The chamber would like to thank Lax Taxidermy for donating the replica of the winning fish, Sunrise Lodge who catered lunch and donated raffle prizes and Miller Beer of the Northwoods who donated beer that was enjoyed at lunch.
