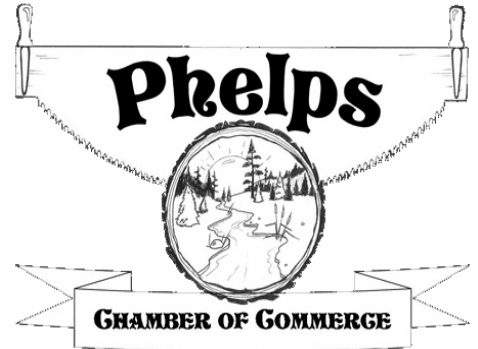

PRESIDENT'S LETTER

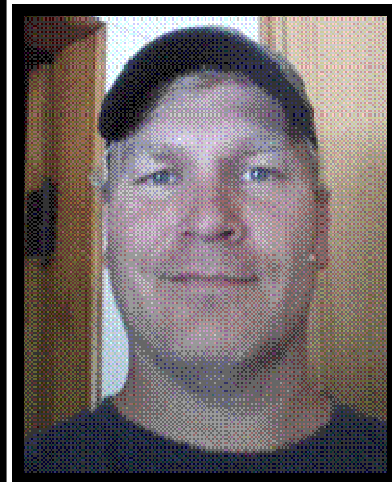
