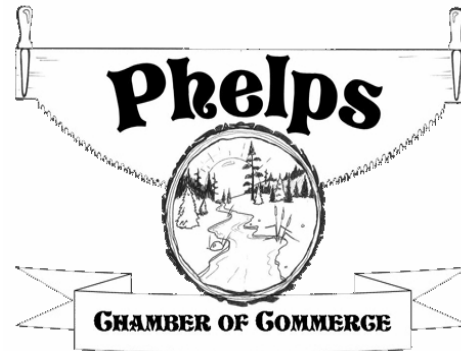

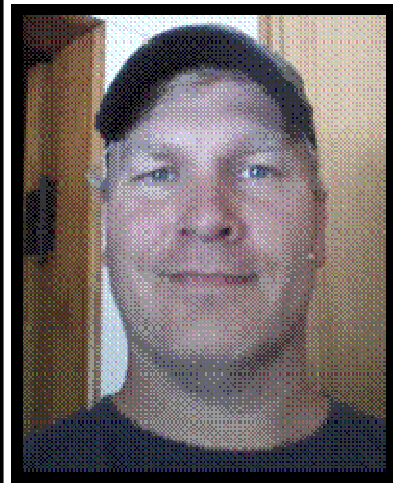
PRESIDENT'S LETTER
