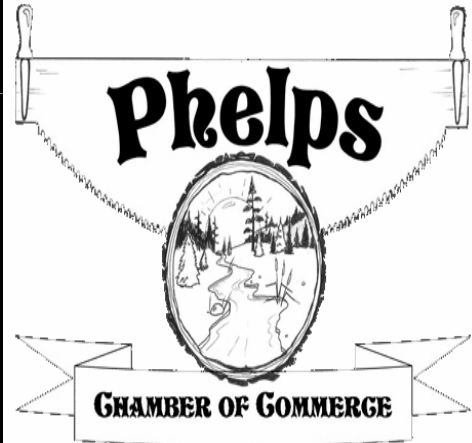

PRESIDENT'S LETTER

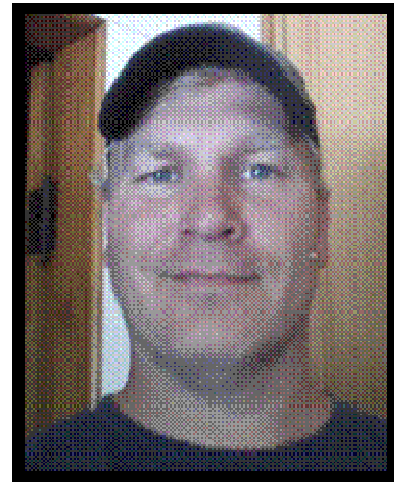
Hi there everyone.
